Inside Out

@ Alison's Field Bethersden, TN26 3JJ

This is a three-phase one-day outdoor event using the Indoor Carriage Driving UK format, dressage test, scoring and rules. It is ideal for newcomers, pre-novices, small ponies/Very Small Equines as well as those wanting to gain experience and have some fun. Drivers who are members of ICD, WHC or a full member of British Carriagedriving or of another BC-affiliated club are insured to compete, otherwise drivers must provide proof of their own insurance to take part in timed competitions. The dressage test for all classes is the ICD 2023-24 Precision & Paces test performed in a 20 x 50m arena with two judges, one marking accuracy and one marking the quality of paces. The cones course has ten cones/multiples, the same optimum time for all classes – based on a speed of 220m/minute – and will be driven prior to your first round of obstacles. Two indoor-style obstacles, flagged A to D or E, are driven twice and timed, each driver taking turns in a small group. There is time allowed for warm-up, practice and short rest periods and the whole event is in the same field. This is an ideal first event or confidence-builder for newcomers. If you have not driven in a British Carriagedriving-affiliated indoor or outdoor competition with your horse or pony before, you must have a (free) safety assessment before you take part. Please contact the Secretary to find out more. There is a harness inspection for all drivers before dressage. The format: you are given a start time for your dressage/P&P. After the dressage, go to the cones course, then, after a break, go to the obstacles and take your turn: times and groups for obstacle driving will be announced on the day. Use the same carriage for all phases – 125cms minimum rear trackwidth. Dress is marathon kit – hard hats must be worn for all phases and body/back protectors for obstacles. Young drivers and grooms – under 18 – must wear body protectors for all phases. The groom may sit beside the driver or stand on the backstep. A bib with your number is provided which is worn by the groom/ back stepper except for solo single small pony drivers who wear the bib themselves and who must have a groom in attendance on the ground. See the ICD rules, the P&P test and other information at www.indoordriving.co.uk. The event timetable, course maps and other information are posted on the WHC Facebook page. Sharing – if you are sharing a carriage or groom, or grooming for another driver, note the other driver's name in the Notes on your entry so we can schedule you both comfortably apart: please enter early! Go twice – a pony or horse may compete twice, provided it is fit enough. The course opens for walking on Saturday afternoon. Park neatly and no closer than 6m to the next lorry to you. If you bring a dog, please keep it under control and on a lead at all times and clear up after it. The Clubhouse will be open for meals and refreshments between 9am and 3pm. Water, toilets, horse waste facilities are on site. Please clear your site of all horse waste before you leave - take your rubbish home. Classes: Single horse, Single pony, Multiples & VSE (11hh and under). Rosettes to sixth place, all classes: Entries: £40 all classes.
