Come and have a fun day driving round our fields over flat ground.

Dressage will run in the morning, followed by cones.

The obstacles will be driven in the afternoon. There will be 4 to be driven once for the short route and twice for the longer course. Only the obstacles will be timed.

Gateway entries (Newcomer and Allcomers) will be accepted from any driver (single or pair) as long as they have not competed at Intermediate level or higher in any BC affiliated Club event or at Novice or above at any BC Regional or National Event. Gateway competitors must have BC or affiliated BC Club membership.

Dressage Arena 80 x 40 m. BC pre novice (2019) - NOVICES, Novice A Test 2023 OPEN AND MULTIPLES. Gateway – Compulsory Shapes 2021.

Marathon dress and marathon width carriages are the order of the day. Hard hats & body protectors to be worn. Two course lengths available: 4 obstacles approx. 3.5 km (once round the venue) or 8 obstacles and 7 km (i.e. 2 circuits).

One section only for all <u>UNLESS</u> you need a competency card signed, please advise in advance. Your card must be handed in to the Show Secretary prior to the competition commencing. (Competitors will drive on a separate Section A at a reduced speed to incorporate the transfer section.) Entries welcome for Small Equine (SE under 12.2 hh) class & competitors will only do the short route of up to 3.5 km and 4 obstacles.

Competitors are permitted to walk obstacles from 4pm on Friday 2nd August. Camping on site from Friday to Sunday permitted. Portable stabling and corrals permitted within the lorry park field. There is no mains water or power at the venue. Please bring water for your horses. An IBC containing water will be made available in the lorry parking field. A muck trailer will be available in the lorry park field. Numbers can be provided.

Social event Saturday night. Please indicate if you wish to stay for BBQ/food.

6. Junior Whips 14 years and under must be accompanied by a competent named adult when driving.

7. Hard hats and body protectors are compulsory for whips and grooms and whilst riding or driving on site.

8. All competitors must be covered by adequate Third-Party Insurance and must sign the declaration to this effect on the Entry Form.

9. Neither the organizing committee of the Weald Harness Club, nor any other landowner, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, save for the death or personal injury caused by negligence of the organizers or any one for in law they are responsible, accepts, any liability, for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness, to horses, owners, driver, grooms, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any way whatsoever.

10. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must themselves also take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards. You will be asked to sign a statement to this effect.

11. Please respect all Out of Bounds areas and park as directed. ***The venue is adjacent to an active private airfield.
